There are various reasons why we use an application and interview process for the Yearbook. First, there are many students who want to be on staff, but classroom space is limited. Yearbook is only offered once per school day.

Next, accurately recording the events of the year is a huge responsibility. Yearbook students must be self-motivated and driven to succeed. This is indicated by the grades they make in their classes. To be considered for the staff, students must maintain an *85 average* or above in all classes and have *no discipline referrals*.

Also, we have deadlines that are set by the Yearbook publishing company. If we miss a deadline, it costs the school large amounts of money to get the book printed and delivered before the end of the school year. Students must have a history of turning work in on time.

Finally, students are often out of the classroom to interview other students and to take photographs for their pages. With that in mind, to be considered for the Yearbook staff, you must maintain more E's than S's in conduct.
